



Clinic Visitor Policy Update

We remain diligent in our efforts to always maintain the health and safety of our patients and staff. The following changes regarding our visitation policy remain in effect:

- Face coverings will need to be worn inside the clinic by staff and patients.
- Of course, COVID-19 vaccination is recommended for women who are contemplating pregnancy or who are pregnant to minimize risks to themselves and their pregnancy.
- We are requesting all patients to please attend your appointment alone.
Spouses/partners/children/parents are not allowed in the facility at this time.
Unfortunately, children will not be allowed in the facility. We ask that you make childcare arrangements prior to appointments.
- We strongly encourage patients that are ill to not attend their appointments to call ahead for instructions.
- New patients and office visits will continue via telehealth until further notice.
- Social distancing is still encouraged. Once the waiting area is at capacity, we may request for patients to wait in vehicles until it is their turn to be seen for their appointment. Lab only appointments will be scheduled 1 per 10 min starting at 7:00 am.
- All semen studies are bring only. Collection kits may be picked up at the front desk.
